

Master Reading and Writing Numbers to 100

Rationale

In this step, pupils will build on their knowledge of reading and writing numbers to 20 from Year 1 to read and write 2-digit numbers to 100 in words and numerals, supported by representations.

They will read and write the numbers from left to right.

Pupils may use a hyphen between the tens and ones words.


Common Errors or Misconceptions

- Pupils may reverse the digits when writing numbers in numerals - for example, 'sixteen' as 61
- Pupils may confuse 'teen' and 'ty' numbers.


