Rationale

In this step, pupils will build on their understanding of writing numbers to 20. They will connect their skills of writing the numerals 0 to 9 to write the numbers 21 to 100. Pupils will write the numbers 21 to 100 in numerals to match given representations and verbal instructions.


Common Errors or Misconceptions

- Pupils may incorrectly form digits. For example, they could be written backwards or upside down. Numbers such as '6' could be written as '9'.
- Pupils may leave too much or not enough space between digits.

Dienes




There are 9 tens, so first I will write 9
