

Master Reading and Writing Numbers to 1,000

Rationale

In this step, pupils will build on their knowledge of reading and writing numbers to 100 from Year 2 to read and write 3-digit numbers to 1,000 in words and numerals, supported by representations.

They will read the numbers from left to right, using 'and' between the hundreds digit and the next digit. For example, one hundred and fifty or one hundred and seven.

Pupils will use hyphens between the tens and ones.
